

Congratulations and thanks for your purchase!

We have tried to make the assembly instructions as clear and concise as possible so you can get on with enjoying your tent quickly and with minimal fuss.

We've also included some tips on how to prolong the life of your tent – if you follow this advice, you will be able to enjoy your tent for years to come!

Contents:

- 1 rain fly
- 3 inner tent
- 1 groundsheet
- 10 fiberglass poles
- 78 tent stakes
- 28 guy ropes
- 1 repair kit

Tent Assembly Instructions, Model: KAHUNA

1. Remove contents of the tent bag
2. Carefully assemble tent poles – do not let the shock cords snap the poles together
3. Unfold the inner tent and the rain fly

Rain Fly

1. Lay out the rain fly evenly on the ground
2. Extend all the fiberglass poles.
3. Insert the color coded poles into the corresponding color coded pole sleeves
4. Insert metal pin (located along bottom edge of inner tent) into the ends of each tent pole
5. The rain fly should now stand freely on the ground
6. Stake down the rain fly through the tent stake loops (located along the bottom edge of the inner tent)
7. Stake down the guy ropes attached to the guy rope tabs on the rain fly – adjust the tension using the tension adjusters on the guy ropes

INNER TENT

1. Take each inner tent to the appropriate area on the inside of the rain fly
2. Hook the inner tents, into the inside of the rain fly by staking down the bottom rear corners and working your way forward to the top using the plastic rings and toggles
3. Do this for the desired number of inner tents – by leaving inner tents out, you can increase the storage or living capacity of the tent as well as shed weight

Caring for your tent:

1. Keep it clean: Don't set up your tent in the mud, avoid putting muddy clothing and gear in the sleeping compartments as sand and dirt can scratch the water proof coating and damage zippers
2. UV light can accelerate fabric degradation. Therefore, set up your tent in the shade when possible and use the rain fly to protect the inner tent
3. To prolong the life of your tent floor, use a separate sheet of PE fabric underneath the tent to protect against abrasion
4. When packing up, shake out dirt and sand as much as possible
5. At home, clean your tent with a damp cloth, never use harsh cleaning chemicals, and air dry
6. When storing, allow the tent to sit loosely to prevent creases
